To do this please read the details including measurements, look at the floor plan and photos, drive-by the location and ask us any questions that may be conditional to your interest going further (e.g views, level plot, size of garden etc.). Please only request a physical inspection of properties which they you have a strong interest in.

We will meet you at the property and seek to maintain a minimum of 2 meters distance. Please wear face covering in line with <u>government guidance</u>.

All parties viewing a property should hand sanitise immediately after entering the property. All internal doors and any gate to garden will be open.

Only two adults will be allowed to view. They must be of the same household. No children please.

Please DO NOT TOUCH anything in the property. The viewing will last around 15 minutes.

The property will be empty and the homeowner will be out. If this is not the case we will advise accordingly.
